

COPING WITH SKUNK SMELL:

- Mix 1 quart of 3% hydrogen peroxide (available at the drugstore) with $\frac{1}{4}$ cup baking soda and 2 teaspoons dishwashing liquid.
- If you have a large breed dog, you may need to double, triple or quadruple the mixture.
- Apply to your dog's dry coat, AVOIDING the eyes.
- Massage the mixture into the coat and skin until the skunk smell starts to dissipate (about 5 minutes). Use a sponge/cloth to apply the solution to the chin, cheeks, forehead and ears, if necessary, being careful not to go near the eyes.
- Rinse thoroughly once the smell starts to decrease. When you rinse the head tilt the chin upwards to ensure the solution does not run into the eyes.
- Repeat, lather and rinse up to three times. Make sure to completely rinse the solution off your dog.
